This is a petition filed under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. for issuance of appropriate directions for an independent and impartial investigation in Zero FIR No.20200008 dated 07.09.2020 under Sections 323/326/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Panipat, District GRP, Ambala Cantt. (Annexure P-1) and subsequent FIR No.532 dated 10.09.2020 under Sections 323/326/34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Chandnibagh, District Panipat, Haryana (Annexure P-2).

Faced with the dictum of law laid down by Hon'ble the Supreme Court of India in case titled **Sakiri Vasu Vs. State of U.P. and others, reported as 2008(2) SCC 409** and in **M. Subramaniam and another Vs. S. Janaki and another, Criminal Appeal No.102 of 2011, decided on**

20.03.2020, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission of this Court to withdraw the present petition with liberty to pursue alternative remedies in accordance with law.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has also submitted that since in the present case, FIR is dated 07.09.2020, the petitioner would be filing the appropriate application within 3 days and requests that in case, such application is filed, the competent Court may be directed to decide the same expeditiously.

In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid.

In case, the said application is filed within a period of three days, the concerned Court is requested to decide the same expeditiously.
