The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.354 dated 08.12.2017 registered under Section 174-A IPC at Police Station Julana, District Jind.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's trial is at its fag end. Therefore, at this stage, he does not press the present petition and would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Trial Court to dispose of the petitioner's trial in a time bound manner.

Learned State counsel has no objection if the alternate prayer made on behalf of the petitioner is accepted.

Considering the totality of the above facts and especially that the petitioner is a senior citizen and allegedly suffering from several ailments as also because his trial is pending for the last about 03 years in which only two prosecution witnesses remain to be examined, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Trial Court to finally adjudicate upon the petitioner's trial within two months from the date of receipt of a copy of this order, in accordance with law.
