The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.472 dated 16.09.2020 registered under Sections 61-A(3)-1-14 of the Excise Act (Haryana Amendment Act 2020) at Police Station Surajkund, District Faridabad.

Vide order dated 04.11.2020, petitioners were directed to join the investigation subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Thereafter on 07.01.2021, learned State counsel on instructions from HC Satbir Singh submitted that though the petitioners had joined the investigation, but they did not co-operate in the investigation. One more opportunity

was granted to the petitioners to join the investigation to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Today, learned State counsel on instructions from HC Satbir Singh submitted that the petitioners have now joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and are no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 04.11.2020 is made absolute. Petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
