These three petitions are filed for grant of anticipatory bail
in FIR No.25, dated 13.10.2020, under Sections 420, 120-B of IPC,
Section 13 (1) (a) of the read with Section 13(2) of Prevention of
Corruption Act, 1988 as amended by P.C. Act, 2018 and Section 36 of
Punjab Apartment & Property Regulation Act, 1995 and (amended) Act,
2014, registered at Police Station Bureau, Range Amritsar District

Amrtisar.

This Court vide order dated 30.10.2020, 05.11.2020 and 11.11.2020, respectively granted the interim bail subject to joining investigation and depositing amount of rupees two lakh.
