1. At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners would be satisfied if the instant petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to decide the representations, Annexure P/5 dated 09.07.2021 and Annexure P/6 dated 19.08.2021 for protection of life and liberty of the petitioners as also for directing the SHO, Police Station Sahnewal, Ludhiana to conduct free, fair and impartial investigation in case FIR No.96 dated 01.06.2021 registered under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station Sahnewal, Police Commissionerate, Ludhiana.

2. Notice to respondent No.3 only.

3. Mr. Hittan Nehra, Addl. A.G., Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3 i.e. Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana and on instructions from SI Harpal Singh states that he has no objection to the limited prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioners.

4. Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners as well as learned State counsel, but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the instant petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representations i.e. Annexure P/5 dated 09.07.2021 and Annexure P/6 dated 19.08.2021 respectively in accordance with law by taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible.
