The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

By filing this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 286 dated 14.10.2020 registered under Section 188 IPC and under Section 5/9 B of Explosive Act, 1884 (wrongly mentioned as Section 5 of Explosive Substance Act, 1908 in column No. 2 of FIR) at Police Station Kosli, District Rewari.

Notice of motion was issued to State. Vide order dated 4.11.2020 petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Order dated 4.11.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner is made absolute. However petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
