The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondent-corporation to immediately release the retiral benefits of the petitioner including pension, DCRG, CPF amount etc. alongwith 18% compounded interest thereon for which, representations dated 19.01.2021 and 12.03.2021 (Annexures P-16 and P-17, respectively) have also been submitted before the respondent-corporation.

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent corporation to duly consider the representations dated 19.01.2021 and 12.03.2021 (Annexures P-16 and P-17, respectively) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
