The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

Petitioner-Daljit Singh stated to be aged 28 years, has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with the prayer for directing the respondents to decide the representation dated 04.08.2021 (Annexure P-5) along with further relief as mentioned in the petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that for same/similar grievance the petitioner had submitted a representation dated 04.08.2021 (Annexure P-5), but the same has not been decided till date.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. T.P.S. Chawla, D.A.G., Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties and without commenting upon the merits of the case, the writ petition is disposed of with

a direction to the respondent No.2/competent authority to consider and

decide the claim of the petitioner as contained in the representation dated 04.08.2021 (Annexure P-5), in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, by passing a speaking order within ***two months*** from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Needless to say that in case the petitioner is found entitled on merits to the claim as raised in the representation, the same be disbursed within ***one month*** from the date of decision of the representation.

It is however, made clear that this order would not be treated to have condoned the delay, if any, in filing the present writ petition.
