AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Present appeal has been filed impugning the order dated 17.09.2021 passed by the learned Single Judge in Criminal Writ Petition, which has been preferred by the appellants, alleging therein threat to their life and liberty.

Learned Single Judge has found that the representation, which has been submitted by the petitioners (appellants herein) to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, District Jalandhar dated 14.09.2021 (Annexure P-3), does not reflect any eminent threat to their life and liberty. What has been apprehended primarily was that they would be

implicated in some false criminal case. The said assertion, on perusal of the representation, has been found to be correct and, therefore, we do not find any justification for interfering with the order passed by the learned Single Judge.

At this stage, learned counsel for the appellants submits that the appellants would make a detailed representation to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, District Jalandhar-respondent No.2, highlighting therein specific details with regard to threat, which they have received at the hands of private respondents.

If such a representation is made, the same shall be looked into by the Senior Superintendent of Police, Jalandhar Rural, District Jalandhar-respondent No.2 and appropriate action in accordance with law, if required, shall be taken. It is made clear that this order, which has been passed by this Court, shall not be construed to be an expression on the merits of the case nor should it be taken as any sort of protection of any criminal case/complaint, which has been filed against the appellants and the law shall take its own course.

With the above observations, the present appeal stands disposed of.
