Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing of FIR No.103 dated 14.09.2016, under Sections 363, 366-A IPC, 1860 and Sections 376 IPC and 3 and 4 POCSO Act, 2012 (added later on), registered at Police Station, Jaitu, District Faridkot and all consequent proceedings arising out of the said FIR.

During the course of hearing, it is not disputed by the learned counsel that after completion of investigation, a final report under Section 173(2) Cr.P.C. was filed against the petitioner, whereupon the charges were also framed by the trial court. Neither the final report nor the order framing charges have been placed on record, therefore, the petition for quashing FIR alone is not maintainable.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition.

The prayer is accepted. The petition is ordered to be dismissed as withdrawn.
