The matter is taken up in the National Lok Adalat through video conferencing.

During the course of hearing, learned counsel for respondent No.3-Insurance Company states that the Insurance Company is ready to pay a sum of Rs.1,55,000/- (Rs. one lakh fifty five thousand only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal, to the appellant.

The said offer is acceptable to learned counsel for the appellant, who states that the appellant shall submit his consent form for accepting the said amount as full and final settlement of his claim, in the office of Lok Adalat.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a demand draft for Rs.1,55,000/- in the name of the appellant in the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within four weeks from today, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall accrue on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue a proper receipt to learned counsel for respondent No.3–Insurance Company, after receipt of the said demand draft. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the demand draft from the office of the Lok Adalat, subject to his submitting the consent form.

Copy of this order be supplied to the parties and their counsel
and the file be returned to the High Court.
