1. Prayer in the instant petition is for initiating action against the respondent for intentional and willful defiance of order Annexure P/1 dated 02.08.2021, in CWP-14385-2021.

2. Learned counsel contends that vide order Annexure P/1 dated 02.08.2021, CWP-14385-2021 was dismissed as withdrawn with liberty to the petitioner to submit a representation and directing the respondent to consider and decide the same by passing a speaking order in accordance with law within two weeks while keeping in view the transfer policy but on failure of the respondent to decide the representation the instant petition was filed but today the petitioner has been supplied copy of order dated 08.10.2021, accepting the claim of the petitioner as made in representation Annexure P/13 and granting the relief prayed for, therefore, the petitioner is not interested in pursuing the contempt petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

02.08.2021, in CWP-14385-2021, having been complied with, the petition be disposed of as not calling for any action against the respondent under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971.

5. I have considered the submissions of learned counsel for the parties.

6. No doubt there is a slight delay in taking decision on the representation but since needful has been done, I am of the considered view that no action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 is called for against the respondent.

7. Contempt petition is disposed of accordingly.
