By this petition, filed under the provisions of Section 438 of the Cr. P.C., the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR no. 227, dated 12.07.2021, having been registered at Police Station Badli, Bahadurgarh, District Jhajjar, alleging therein the commission of an offence punishable under Section 17 of the NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ashok Kumar, submits that pursuant to the order of this court dated 30.09.2021, the petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

That being so and for the reasons already recorded in that order, the said order dated 30.09.2021 is made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.

However, if the petitioners' custodial interrogation is required at any stage hereinafter, in the context of the FIR in question, he would be given 10 days notice before arrest, duly shown to be served upon him.
