Main case (O&M)

Present writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/ 227 of the
Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Certiorari for
quashing the selection and appointment of Ward Sahayika by the respondents
in pursuance of advertisement dated 20.02.2016 (P-1). Further prayer is for
issuance of direction to the respondents for conducting selection process *de
novo* pursuant to the above said advertisement.

On oral request of learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 6, next date of hearing fixed in the main case, i.e. 16.03.2021 is pre-poned and the same is taken up on board today itself.

Learned counsel for respondents No.1 to 6 while making reference to para-2 of CM-3609-CWP-2021, has apprised the Court that during the pendency of the present writ petition, petitioner applied for the post of MTS (*safaiwali*) and she was selected as well as appointed at MH Kasauli vide order dated 09.11.2017 (R-1/6). Further submitted that petitioner, being a couple case, has been transferred at a place of her choice, i.e. HQ PH & HP (I) Sub Area Ambala Cantt., vide order dated 03.02.2020; thus, the grievance of the petitioner is redressed and present petition becomes infructuous.

In view of the stand taken by respondents No.1 to 6, it is apparently clear that petitioner has been selected & appointed on the post of MTS (*safaiwali*) and her further posting is also made as per her choice; therefore, her claim stands satisfied and no further directions are required to be issued in this case.

As a result thereof, petition stands disposed off.

Pending application(s), if any, shall also stand disposed off, accordingly.
