The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant/release the complete retiral/pensionary service benefits due to the petitioner (including gratuity, dearness allowance, GPF/PF deposited by him, leave encashment, medical allowance etc. and arrears of increment and other arrears) alongwith interest @ 18% per annum, for which, representations

dated 10.08.2021 and 20.09.2021 (Annexures P-2 and P-3, respectively) have also been submitted before the respondent authorities.

Heard.

At the asking of the Court Ms. Simran Grewal, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Let copy of the paper book be supplied to her.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent authorities to duly consider the representations dated 10.08.2021 and 20.09.2021 (Annexures P-2 and P-3, respectively) and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to him without any delay as per law.
