Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.284 dated 22.07.2020 registered under Section 5/13(2), 17 of the Haryana Gauvansh Sanrakshan and Gausamvardhan Act, 2015 and Sections 11-59-60 of the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act, 1960 and Section 120-B IPC, at Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Nuh, Haryana.

Vide order dated 18.11.2020, passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from S.I Kanwar Pal, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation. He, however, states that the petitioner was granted interim bail on the fact that he was neither the owner nor the conductor of the truck but later on, it was found that the said truck was released on Sapurdari in the name of the petitioner.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 18.11.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
