Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for directing the respondents to pay the back wages to the petitioner commencing from the year 2015 to 14.09.2018, when the service of the petitioner was illegally terminated.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, states that at this stage, instead of pressing the petition on merits, his client would be satisfied, in case, representation dated 22.10.2019 (P-6) is decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Maloo Chahal, DAG, Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State. Learned State counsel raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without

going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3-Chief Executive Officer-cum-Principal, Government College, Roopnagar, Tehsil & District Roopnagar, Punjab, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 22.10.2019 (P-6), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
