The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.228 dated 16.06.2020 registered under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 120-B IPC at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the co-accused namely Ajay and Satish allegedly furnished forged documents. Petitioner was not named in the FIR, but he was arrayed as an accused later on. There is no link evidence to connect the petitioner with the complicity of co-accused namely Ajay and Satish, who have already been released on regular

bail. Similarly situated co-accused namely Inder Mohan, who was also not named in the FIR has also been granted anticipatory bail vide order dated 26.10.2020 passed in CRM-M No.29224 of 2020. Notice of motion was issued on 05.11.2020 on the aforesaid premise.

Learned counsel further submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation.

The aforesaid fact has been admitted by learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Rajesh Kumar. Learned State counsel further stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation on 13.03.2021 to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer and is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 05.11.2020 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
