This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking directions to respondents No. 1 to 3 to get the FIR No. 156 dated 8.8.2021, under Section 279 and 304-A IPC, registered at Police Station, East Sector 26, Chandigarh investigated from the officer of the rank of Deputy Superintendent of Police.

Learned counsel for Union Territory, Chandigarh appearing on advance notice submits that the matter is being investigated. Two CCTV footages, one inside the club and the other outside the club are with the investigating agency and the same have been sent to FSL.
