The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.351 dated 05.07.2019 under Sections 34, 406 and 498-A IPC registered at Police Station Ambala Cantt, District Ambala.

As per the report received from the Mediation and Conciliation Center of this Court, the parties have arrived at an amicable settlement. As per the compromise arrived at between the parties, it has been agreed that the petitioner would give a demand draft in the sum of Rs.18 lakhs to the complainant

Learned Senior Counsel for the petitioner submits that out of the amount of Rs.18 lakhs as agreed between the parties, Rs.2 lakhs stands paid to the complainant through demand draft. A photocopy of

the same which has been placed on record. He further submits that in compliance of order dated 04.02.2020, the petitioner has also joined the investigation.

Learned State Counsel assisted by learned Senior Counsel for the complainant, on instructions from the investigating officer has not disputed the submissions made by the counsel opposite and has submitted that the petitioner is not required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and interim order dated 04.02.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
