Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the private respondents No. 4 to 7 have committed fraud as they took a sum of Rs. 25 lacs from the petitioner on the pretext of sending the petitioner abroad by performing his marriage with respondent No. 4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that though, the said complaint has already been filed before respondent No. 2, but no action has been taken so far. Learned counsel further submits that even after filing the complaint/representation dated 27.07.2021 (Annexure P-1), a reminder to the said complaint was also submitted by the petitioner on 20.09.2021 (Annexure P-2) but the same has not resulted into any action. Learned counsel for the petitioner prays that

respondent No. 2 be directed to decide the complaint/representations dated 27.07.2021 and 20.09.2021 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sandeep Singh Deol, learned Deputy Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conference, keeping in view the service of advance copy of petition, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State. Learned State counsel raises no objection in deciding the complaints/representations dated 27.07.2021 and 20.09.2021 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case or the claim being made by the petitioner in the complaints/representations dated 27.07.2021 and 20.09.2021, the respondent is directed to decide the complaints/representations dated 27.07.2021 and 20.09.2021 (Annexures P-1 and P-2) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order.

It will be appreciated that before passing the order, the persons, who are likely to be effected, be also heard.

Present petition stands disposed of.
