1. The petitioners have approached this Court seeking quashing of FIR No.156 dated 23.05.2020 registered against them at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula, under Sections 148/149/323/452/379-B/506 IPC (Sections 201/411 IPC added later on) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom on the basis of a compromise having been effected between the parties.
2. Vide order dated 05.11.2020, the parties had been directed to appear before the Illaqa Magistrate/trial Court so as to get their statements recorded qua the factum of compromise.
3. Report of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Panchkula, has been received, wherein it has been reported that the statements of accused/petitioners Amitabh @ ME, Ashish Jakhar, Amit

Mor/Kumar @ Meeta and Vikas @ Kimmat and also of injured/complainants Rohit Sheokand, Mohit Sheokand and Daya Nand Sheokand have been recorded to the effect that they have compromised the matter amongst themselves.

4. The injured/complainants Rohit Sheokand, Mohit Sheokand and Daya Nand Sheokand in their separate statements have stated that they have no objection in case the FIR in question is quashed.
5. The learned Additional Sessions Judge, Panchkula, has specifically opined that the parties have entered into compromise voluntarily without there being any pressure, coercion and undue influence.
6. In view of the aforesaid compromise and bearing in mind the law laid down by Full Bench of this Court in 2007(3) RCR (Crl.) 1052 Kulwinder Singh and others Vs. State of Punjab, the present petition is allowed and FIR No.156 dated 23.05.2020 registered at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula, under Sections 148/149/323/452/379-B/506 IPC (Sections 201/411 IPC added later on) and all subsequent proceedings emanating therefrom are hereby quashed qua petitioners.
