AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is filed seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 224 dated 6.9.2021, under Sections 420, 467, 468, 506 and 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Chheharta, District Amritsar.

As per the allegations, the petitioner duped the complainant for Rs.12,00,000/- on the pretext of getting him Fastag Contract for the State of Punjab. The dispute surviving was of refund of Rs.4,00,000/-.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Though the complainant has not been impleaded as party, Mr.Arjunveer Sharma, Advocate puts in appearance on behalf of the complainant. He admits the factum of matter having been compromised.

As no recovery is to be made, it is not a case of custodial interrogation, the petitioner is granted anticipatory bail subject to his joining investigation within two weeks. In the event of his arrest, the petitioner shall be released on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer. He is directed to join the

investigation as and when called for. He shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

The petition is allowed.

In case of failure of petitioner to join the investigation, the State would be at liberty to file an application for re-calling of this order.
