The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.312 dated 19.09.2020 registered under Sections 363 and 366-A of IPC at Police Station Sultanpur Lodhi, District Kapurthala.

On 09.11.2020, following order was passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court:-

The matter is being taken up through Video Conferencing/WhatsApp due to pandemic of COVID-19.

Learned counsel for the petitioners, inter alia, contends that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in the present case being the parents of the main accused, namely, Satpal Singh @ Laddi. The petitioners have also been making efforts for tracing out their son and even taken the assistance of the police. No specific allegation against the petitioners have been made. The petitioners are ready and willing to join investigation.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr.H.S.Multani, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State of Punjab. Learned counsel for the State to seek instructions and file report by the next date of hearing.

Meanwhile, the petitioners are directed to join investigation as and when called for by the Investigating Officer. The petitioners will fully cooperate with the Investigating Officer. In the event of arrest, the petitioners shall be released on ad interim bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer/Investigating Officer, subject to their compliance of the conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
