The matter has been taken up through Video conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking issuance of directions to the respondents, especially to respondent No.4 to release the retiral benefits of pension, family pension, death-cum-retirement gratuity, leave encashment and other benefits alongwith interest @18% per annum, for which, legal notices dated 14.04.2021 and 01.06.2021 (Annexure P-11 and P-12, respectively) have also been served upon the respondent-authorities.

Heard.

Upon hearing the learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the especially respondent No.4 to duly consider the legal notices dated 14.04.2021 and 01.06.2021 (Annexure P-11 and P-12, respectively) in the light of the orders passed by the superior officers vide orders dated 04.05.2021, 18.05.2021 and 15.06.2021 (Annexure P-13 to P-15) as representation of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioner is held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to her without any delay as per law.
