The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

The petitioner has come up in this civil writ petition under articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking a prayer by way of writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to re-fix the pension of the petitioner by stepping up their pay at par with their juniors and direct the respondents to decide representations dated 04.05.2018 and 19.09.2018 (Annexure P-3 Colly.) with further prayer to issue writ of certiorari quashing letter dated 03.04.2018 (Annexure P-4) and to pay the arrears alongwith interest @ 18% per annum..

Heard.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioner, the directions are issued to the respondent-authorities to duly consider representations dated 04.05.2018 and 19.09.2018 (Annexure P-3 Colly.) of the petitioner and decide the same in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of one month from the date of passing of this order.

If the petitioners are held entitled for so claimed relief and there is no impediment for granting the same, the relief be released to them without any delay as per law.
