Case heard via video conferencing.

By this petition, the petitioner seeks the concession of anticipatory bail, upon FIR no.32, dated 31.3.2020, having been registered at Police Station Sehna, District Barnala, alleging therein the commission of offences punishable under Sections 353/186/188 of the IPC.

An affidavit dated 17.11.2021 has been filed by the DSP Sub-Division, Tapa, which is ordered to be taken on record.

In essence, what is stated in the affidavit is to the effect that the petitioner had prevented the police from entering her house, with her co-accused having (as alleged) attacked the police officials who were attempted to enter it and that she has misbehaved with the police officials but with the video CD not exactly being very clear.

Other than stating that one of the police officials had no turban on his head, the DSP has actually refrained from giving any comment.

In view of the above, without making any comment on the actual merits of the case, the petition is allowed with the order dated 30.09.2021 made absolute, on the same terms and conditions.
