Writ petition under Article 226 of the Constitution has been filed, *inter alia*, for issuance of direction to the respondents to remove the anomaly between senior and junior Art and Craft teachers.

Learned counsel, on instructions from the petitioner, instead of pressing the petition on merits, confines his prayer that legal notice dated 01.07.2021 (P-2) be decided expeditiously.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioners.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off

with direction to respondent No.2, to consider and decide the aforesaid legal notice dated 01.07.2021 (P-2), in accordance with law by passing speaking order, within a period of six months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
