The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 245 dated 02.08.2021, under Sections 419, 420, 467, 468, 471, 34 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Gannaur, District Sonipat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner was to be a witness to the sale deed whereby the owner of the plot, namely, Smt. Saroj Devi had been impersonated by Smt. Santosh. He also contends that the sale deed could not be registered as the Sub Registrar had suspected something amiss. The petitioner does not have criminal antecedents.

Issue notice to the respondent

This Court, by order dated 04.10.2021 had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Rajesh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 04.10.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
