On 29.10.2021, the following order was passed:-

“ Reply dated 27.10.2021 by way of affidavit of Lakhbir Singh Brar, Superintendent, Central Jail, Amabala has been filed on behalf of respondent No.1 to 5.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is directed to get instructions as to what rituals have to be now undertaken by the petitioner about 1 ½ month after the death of the brother of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner seeks some time to get instructions.

Adjourned to 10.11.2021.”

Learned counsel states that *Trayodashi* has to be conducted.

However, we are not convinced that there would be any such essential ritual on the death of a person which has to be conducted after so much time, i.e. after 27.09.2021, when the death stated to have taken place.

In the circumstances, no relief can be granted to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition stands dismissed.
