This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.86 dated 12.09.2020, under Sections 307, 324, 323, 294, 506, 148 & 149 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Jodhan, District Ludhiana.

[2]. Ld. Counsel for the petitioner has sent up through e-mail a copy of the Affidavit sworn by the complainant Gurdeep Singh along with a copy of the Panchayati Compromise entered into between the parties to submit that the dispute between them has been amicably compromised.
