The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioners in FIR No.107 dated 30.8.2020 registered under Sections 323, 506, 498-A and 34 IPC at Police Station Sadar Rajpura, District Patiala.

By virtue of the order dated 31.8.2021, while granting interim protection, the petitioners were directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioners that the petitioners have joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute. He further submits that the parties have arrived at some settlement.

Learned counsel for the complainant submits that he is not aware of the fact of the settlement.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harvinder Singh has endorsed the fact that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 31.8.2021 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. and the petition stands allowed.
