The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 36 dated 04.06.2021, under Sections 323, 324, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Section 326 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Kacha Pacca, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner and the incident is the outcome of a sudden quarrel with regard to irrigation of fields.

Heard.

The allegations against the petitioner in the FIR are that he along with co-accused Balwinder Singh had fired shots with a rifle which hit on the right shoulder of the uncle of the complainant. This is the second petition for anticipatory bail. The previous petition, i.e. CRM-M No. 38238 of 2021, was

dismissed as withdrawn on 15.09.2021.

In view of serious allegations against the petitioner, I do not deem it to be a fit case to grant the concession of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Consequently, the petition stands dismissed.

However, it is clarified that nothing which has been observed here-in-above shall be deemed to have any bearing on the merits of the case.

Pending application(s), if any, shall stand disposed of.
