

PAWAN KUMAR VS. RAJIV ALIAS RAJU AND OTHERS

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At the very outset, learned counsel for the appellant would contend that an application bearing No. 7054-CII-2021 seeking impleadment of legal heirs of the appellant, since the appellant died on 10.05.2019 is pending.

Registry is directed to list the same today itself.

For the reasons mentioned, the application is allowed.

Amended memo of parties is taken on record.

As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the LR of the deceased appellant, learned counsel and representative of the respondent – Insurance Company (separately recorded), a sum of Rs. 1,50,000/- (Rupees One Lakh Fifty Thousand Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants, the enhanced amount be paid to the LRs of the appellant in equal shares.

Accordingly, we **dispose of** this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque for Rs. 1,50,000/- in the name of all three LRS of the appellant with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court within one month, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheque to learned counsel/representative of the respondent – Insurance Company. The appellants or their counsel may collect the cheque from

the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
