The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.92 dated 13.09.2020, registered under Sections 323, 324, 452, 506, 148, 149 IPC (Section 325 IPC added later) at Police Station Singh Bhagwantpur, District Rupnagar.

The operative part of the order dated 09.11.2020, vide which interim anticipatory bail has been granted to the petitioners, is reproduced as under:-

“...Learned Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. The case involved version and cross-version as DDR No.21 dated 13.09.2020 has been registered on complaint of Hussan Pal regarding the alleged occurrence. As per the DDR, Hussan Pal was beaten by Rulda Singh and his sons Mohan Singh, Sohan Singh and Harpal Singh. Totally false and concocted allegations

have been levelled against the petitioner. Petitioner No.1 was not present even in the village at the time of alleged occurrence. The version given in the FIR as to inflicting of blow with gandasi on left leg of Sandeep Singh is not supported by his MLR which shows that injury was caused with sharp edged weapon on his forearm while injury on his left leg was caused with blunt weapon. The petitioners are ready to join the investigation.

Notice of motion....”

Counsel for the petitioners has submitted that, in pursuance to the order dated 09.11.2020, the petitioners have appeared before the Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Counsel for the State assisted by counsel for the complainant and on instructions from ASI Sohan Lal, has not disputed the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners vide order dated 09.11.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
