The petitioners have invoked the jurisdiction of this Court in terms of Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking prayer by way of writ of *certiorari* for quashing the action of the respondents in making the recovery of amounts at the rate of Rs.4.91/- per quintal from the petitioners on account of reduction of allowance for kharif marketing season 2014-15.

Upon hearing learned counsel of both the sides and on perusal of the records, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider the representations dated 13.08.2021 and 07.09.2021 (Annexures P-13 and P-14, respectively) moved by the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law, by passing a speaking order preferably within a period of one month from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.

If found entitled and if there is no impediment for the release of payment, the same be granted to the petitioners without any delay, as per law.

The petition stands disposed off accordingly.

During the pendency of the representation, no coercive means shall be adopted by the respondents against the petitioners.
