Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.250 dated 29.07.2018 registered under Sections 379-A, 420, 427, 34 IPC (later Section 379-A converted to Section 379-B) and Section 25 of the Arms Act, at Police Station Ferozepur Jhirka, District Nuh.

Vide order dated 28.08.2019 passed by a Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner was granted *ad-interim* anticipatory bail and directed to join the investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the order dated 28.08.2019 passed by the Coordinate Bench of this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from HC Satish

Kumar, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is now not required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 28.08.2019 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
