The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India challenges the show cause notice dated 09.9.2021 (Annexure P-4) issued by respondent No.4, in which he has been given liberty to file the reply within a week, failing which the matter would be decided *ex parte*.

In the considered opinion of this Court, the matter is pre-mature at this stage. It is open to the petitioner to raise all his defences before the said competent authority and if an order is passed adverse to the petitioner, it is always open to him to challenge the same in accordance with law.

Accordingly, the present writ petition stands disposed of with the aforesaid liberty.
