MAHABIR SINGH SINDHU. J.

Civil writ petition is filed under Article 226 of the Constitution for issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents to evaluate the OMR sheet of petitioner and declare his result.

In pursuance of the previous order, learned State counsel has produced the decision dated 26.10.2021 taken by the Board which, *inter-alia*, reads as under:-

“The approval is granted to evaluate the OMR sheets on the basis of the attendance sheet of those candidates, who have not marked the Question Booklet Alphabetic Series (A/B/C/D) in their OMR sheets for the Second stage Examination held on 05.09.2021, for the post of Zildar, Patwari and Irrigation Booking Clerk.”

In view of the above, learned counsel on instructions from petitioner submits that his grievance has been redressed and as such he does not wish to press the petition any further.

Consequently, there is no option except to dispose off the writ petition as having been rendered infructuous.

Ordered accordingly.
