Present civil writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing of order dated 22.01.2020 (P-9) passed by learned Special Judge, CBI Court, Chandigarh, whereby application submitted by the petitioner for granting permission/NOC for issuance of a new passport to the petitioner in Case bearing NO.RCCHG2017A0011 dated 05.05.2017 under Section 120-B IPC and 7, 13(1) (d) read with Section 13(2) of the Prevention of Corruption Act, has been rejected.
