When the matter was taken up for arguments, learned State counsel has informed that in the instant case challan already stands presented and the matter is now fixed before the trial Court for 27.10.2021 to consider framing of charges.

Faced with the aforestated position, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he may be permitted to withdraw the instant petition at this stage with liberty to raise all the pleas, as raised herein, before the trial Court at appropriate stage.

In view of the aforestated submission, the petition is dismissed as withdrawn.

Needless to mention, in case the petitioner raises pleas at the stage of consideration of framing of charges including his plea as regards the delay and regarding his false implication on account of property dispute between the petitioner and his uncle, the trial Court shall consider the same by way of passing a speaking order.
