This is a petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 281 dated 16.8.2021 registered under Sections 148, 149, 323, 452, 506 IPC at Police Station Civil Line, Sirsa.

FIR was lodged on the complaint of one Saroj Devi who stated that on 13.8.2021 at about 9.30 pm she alongwith her sister Lakshmi, niece Sonia and daughter in law Shalu were present in their house. Meanwhile, Chintu (petitioner), knocked at their door and forcibly entered the house. He was accompanied by Monu and Mukesh. The petitioner who was armed with an axe inflicted blow with axe which hit on the left side of head of complainant. Makesh threw a brick towards Shalu (daughter in law of complainant). However, it did not hit her. Monu inflicted a kirch blow on the niece of complainant Sonia which hit on her head. The petitioner gave an axe blow on left shoulder of sister of complainant Sharda. On hearing the noise, Krishna and Hajju came to the street in front of their house. They also scuffled with complainant party. One Vicky came to spot to rescue the complainant party. However, petitioner inflicted a blow with danda of axe on his head. Thereafter, the assailants fled away.

It has come on record that one of the injuries inflicted by the accused was on the cheek bone of Sonia who is aged about 16 years.

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The petitioner was a member of unlawful assembly which had trespassed into the house of complainant and inflicted injuries. One of the injuries inflicted is a fracture on the cheek of niece of complainant Sonia (who is a minor) which is grievous.

In view of aforesaid, no ground for grant of anticipatory bail to petitioner is made out.

Dismissed.
