CRM-M-36591 of 2020

Present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. seeking grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 254 dated 17.09.2020, under Sections 379-B IPC, registered at Police Station Ram Nagar, Karnal, District Karnal.

The allegations in the FIR are that the accused snatched Rs. 3100/- from the complainant and also gave punch blows to the complainant.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is in custody since 25.09.2020 and the matter has been compromised with the complainant. He has placed on record the compromise dated 30.03.2021 (Annexure A-1).

Learned counsel for the complainant also affirms the factum of compromise.

The investigation in the case is complete. Without commenting anything on merits of the case and keeping in view the fact that the matter has been compromised with the complainant and the trial is likely to take long time to conclude in the near future more so in the wake of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19, no useful purpose will be served by keeping the petitioner behind the bars till the conclusion of trial.

Accordingly, this petition is allowed. Petitioner-Raja is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
