1. The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.450 dated 11.08.2020 registered under Section 306 of IPC at Police Station Sadar, District Gurugram.

2. It is contended that the allegations, as set out in the FIR, would not constitute an offence under Section 306 IPC while contending that there is no suicide note that has been left behind. It is submitted that the parties were in relationship. However, the petitioner had not instigated the deceased to commit suicide. It is further submitted that in terms to the order dated 10.11.2020, the petitioner has joined the investigation. However, as the Investigating Officer required his signatures, he re-joined the investigation as per order dated 22.12.2020. It is submitted that even as per the status

report filed in Court, the specimen signature and handwriting of the

petitioner has been taken before the learned JMIC, Gurugram and the same have been now sent to RFSL, Bhondsi for examination. Apart from that, the petitioner has submitted his phone and his Pan Card to the Investigating Officer.

3. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State, on instructions from Inspector Rajni Rani, would submit that the petitioner is not cooperating and is evading to give the relevant answers to questions posed.

4. In view of the fact that the petitioner herein has handed over the necessary documents as has been noticed in the status report, the instant petition is allowed and the order dated 10.11.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
