The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C., read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., for grant of interim regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.387, dated 22.11.2017, under Sections 302, 303 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar Jind, District Jind.

In compliance of order dated 26.11.2020, status report by way of an affidavit of Sadhu Ram, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Jind, District Jind, on behalf of the State has been filed through e-mail. The same is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions.

A perusal of the status report so filed by the State reveals that the wife of the petitioner for whose surgery the petitioner is seeking the concession of interim bail has declined to get herself operated.

Still further, the learned State counsel has apprised the Court that the petitioner has a grown-up son who is about 21 years of age besides one

daughter and another son aged 16 years and 14 years respectively, who in the eventuality of the wife of the petitioner being operated upon, would be able to take care of her and nurse her. Not only this, the learned State counsel has submitted that the trial is nearing completion as 27 out of 29 prosecution witnesses cited have been examined.

Heard.

In the circumstances, no ground is made out. Dismissed.
