This is a petition for anticipatory bail filed on behalf of the petitioner under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.243 dated 05.08.2019, under Sections 342, 365 & 394 of the IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959 (Section 412 of the IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Khol, District Rewari.

[2]. Notice of motion.

[3]. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Bhupender Singh, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana to accept notice on behalf of the respondent. Let a copy of the Paper-book be supplied to him.

[4]. It has been submitted on behalf of the petitioner that his name was not mentioned as culprit in the FIR. He relies upon the Affidavit sworn by the complainant Jaiveer (Annexure P-2), in which the complainant had exonerated the petitioner by stating that he was not involved in the occurrence. The name of the petitioner has transpired from the disclosure statement of the co-accused, namely, Sanjay Singh @ Gandhi. The vehicle,

in question, was already recovered from one Pintu Sisodia, who purchased it from the co-accused Sanjay Singh @ Gandhi. Challan against three co-accused persons was submitted long ago. Charges have also been framed against them. No role is attributed to the present petitioner.

[5]. For the aforesaid reasons, the present petition is disposed off by granting the relief of anticipatory bail to the petitioner subject to his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, he shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
