The petitioners are seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 287 dated 09.11.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 323, 447, 452, 506 and 307 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 ('IPC' - for short) (Section 307 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Chhainsa, District Faridabad.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that although the petitioners are named in the FIR, but no specific injury is attributed to them. It is alleged that co-accused had put rope around the neck of the injured and tried to kill him. The injured has fully recovered from the injuries.

This Court, by the order dated 04.10.2021, had directed the petitioners to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of their arrest, they were ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Naresh Kumar, states that the petitioners have joined investigation.

In view of the above, especially when the petitioners having joined investigation, the order dated 04.10.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioners is made absolute.

However, the petitioners shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. They shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
