This is the first petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.25 dated 03.03.2021 lodged under Sections 354C, 376(2)(n), 406, 506 and 120-B of the IPC and Section 3 of the SC/ST Act registered at Women Police Station Gurugram, District Gurugram.

In compliance of order dated 11.10.2021, status report by way of affidavit of Pankhuri Kumar, HPS, Assistant Commissioner of Police, CAW East, Gurugram with respect to the medical condition of the petitioner has been filed by the learned State counsel which is taken on record subject to all just exceptions.

As per the status report, the petitioner has indeed been diagnosed with gangrene scrotum and lower abdomen for which debridement and narcotic skin and biopsy were done on him at PGIMS Rohtak and thereafter he was admitted in the Jail Hospital, Gurugram.

It has also been stated that the medical condition of the petitioner is poor.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would restrict his prayer to the grant of interim bail on medical grounds as his family would like to get him treated from a private hospital. A prayer has, therefore, been made to extend the concession of interim bail to the petitioner for a period of six weeks so that he could get himself treated from a private hospital without any further delay.

Heard.

In view of the facts and circumstances as enumerated above, the petition is disposed of with the directions that the petitioner be admitted to interim bail for a period of six weeks to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned, from the date of release. The petitioner would surrender back to the jail authorities on expiry of the period of interim bail.
