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SUVIR SEHGAL, J. (Oral)

The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and family members, which is under imminent threat at the hands of respondents No.5 to 7, who are the relations of the husband of petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is married to Sanjeev Malik on 05.05.2003 and two children have been born out of the wedlock. He submits that the petitioner and her husband jointly own 3½ acres of land, which has been sold off by the private respondents taking

advantage of the fact that the husband of the petitioner is a drug addict and remained admitted in De-addiction Centre as is apparent from the OPD slip dated 01.07.2021, Annexure P-1. Counsel submits that before approaching this Court, the petitioner submitted a comprehensive representation dated 20.09.2021, Annexure P-2 to the Superintendent of Police, Panipat – respondent No.3, but the same has not been attended to. Counsel submits that the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the representation.

Request made by counsel for the petitioner has been considered.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Superintendent of Police, Panipat – respondent No.3 to examine the representation dated 20.09.2021, Annexure P-2 submitted by the petitioner and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law in case any substance is found in the same.

A copy of this order as well as representation dated 20.09.2021, Annexure P-2 be communicated to respondent No.3 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
