The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for quashing the FIR No.25, dated 27.02.2021 (Annexure P-1), registered under Sections 323, 34, 406, 498A, 506 of IPC at Women Police Station, District Sonipat.

Counsel for the petitioners herein would contend that there is enough evidence available with them to establish the fact that a false FIR has been registered and it is on the basis of these documents, quashing has been sought. It is submitted that all these documents have been submitted to the Investigating Officer, however, none of these documents have been taken into account while presenting the challan.

Notice of motion.

At this stage, Ms. Mahima Yashpal, DAG, Haryana, has put in appearance through the medium of video conferencing and accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. She would submit that the matter has already been investigated and challan has been presented and in case, the petitioners herein are not satisfied with the investigation done, there are remedies available to them.

Faced with this, counsel for the petitioners does not press the instant petition, however, seeks liberty to challenge the investigation done.

The present petition is disposed of by allowing the petitioners to avail all remedies in accordance with law.
